

Sports and Societies Schedule

1.0 UPSU members may establish individual sports clubs and societies

1.1 A club shall refer to a group of students partaking in sporting activity whilst a society shall refer to any other non-sporting activity.

1.2 A club or society may be formed from time to time if:

1.2.1 They have the formal support of at least 20 other members

1.2.2 They submit the required paperwork, including but not limited to, a constitution and health and safety assessment

1.2.3 They have an elected committee of officers who will administer the club or society, at least including a:

1.2.3.1 Chairperson

1.2.3.2 Treasurer

1.2.3.3 Secretary

1.2.3.4 Health and Safety officer

1.3 Each club or society shall be affiliated to UPSU and must abide by its constitution and be financially accountable to its Board of Trustees

1.4 Each club or society must be open to all members of UPSU

1.5 Each club or society must have an Annual General Meeting (AGM) in the spring term which should be conducted in line with the Meetings Guidelines Schedule

1.6 Each club or society must abide by the financial regulations of UPSU and with any additional regulations set out in the Clubs & Societies Handbook

1.7 Each club or society must abide by health and safety regulations

1.8 Each club or society must abide by the equal opportunities schedule

1.9 Each club or society must send a committee representative to the Sports & Societies Sub-Committee of Student Parliament

1.9.1 Failure to send a representative on three (3) consecutive occasions to the Sports & Societies Sub-Committee will result in club or society budget freezing

1.9.2 Clause 1.9.1 may be over ruled at the discretion of the appropriate Vice President

2.0 Each club or society must send a committee representative and encourage other members to attend the Annual General Meeting (AGM)

2.0.1 Any club that fails to send a representative to AGM, unless agreed beforehand with the appropriate Vice President, will not be eligible for a stand at the Sports and Societies Fair in the following academic year.
