

Are you thinking about offering a "taster" session to students who aren't currently members? It's a great way to provide non-members a flavour of what your society does. Give it a Go sessions are a great opportunity to get your society out there and increase your membership. Sessions can be held at any time throughout the year and can be one off sessions/weekly/fortnightly.

The department can offer you additional support and advertising through the Give it a Go programme. You can be as creative as you like and it's completely up to you how you design and deliver the session.

## Decide on your society's Give it a Go Session and the content.

What will the session be? What will it involve? How will you run the session? Think about the structure, layout and what you would like to offer students. **Remember, keep it fun!** 

Will you need equipment? Transport? Indoors or outdoors? What space will you require? What is the session called?

## Decide how many Give it a Go Sessions you would like to hold.

A one off, weekly, monthly? Time of the year? Pick dates and times that will work for the majority. Think about your society members and who can help. Decide on solid times and dates.

### Book the space you need.
