useful abilities and previous experiences

requirements

- **1.** Be the key representative link between students on your course, School Reps/Lead Reps, your college (If applicable), the University and UPSU.
- **2.** To proactively engage with students at a course level and collate any feedback relating to the academic experience of students.
- **3.** Present student feedback at relevant college (if applicable) and/or university meetings in a constructive and professional way.
- **4.** To communicate key information and outcomes back to the students on your course.
- **5.** Work closely with School Reps/Lead Rep, the Faculty/College Lead and the VP Education to present student feedback to the university, where appropriate.
- 6. To uphold the democratic principles of UPSU and to act in a fair and unbiased way.
- **7.** To behave in a manner that maintains the good reputation of UPSU, the college (if applicable), the University and the role.
- **8.** To be an advocate for UPSU campaigns and engagement opportunities, including UPSU Elections and the UPSU Annual Student Meeting.
- **9.** To engage fully in UPSU democratic processes and to be accountable to the student body.
