

The SU Volunteering Award – Dedicated Student Volunteer Reflective Discussion With An SU Staff Member Examples of Evidence to Showcase Your Efforts

For your upcoming reflective discussion with an SU Staff Member, you will need to take along one piece of evidence (digital or physical), that shows the results of the efforts you have been putting into your extra-curricular voluntary role. This evidence does not need to be something elaborate as the following list of examples suggests:

- A photograph of you undertaking a task.
- Minutes from a group/committee meeting.
- Number of students engaged in your club/society/activity.
- Feedback from fellow students.
- Your group's budget/financial records.
- Outputs from an event (i.e. what shows that your event was a success or that it didn't go so well).
- Money raised for charity.
- Outputs from a campaign (i.e. what shows that your campaign was a success, or that it didn't go so well).
- Feedback from UPSU/Uni Staff Members.
- Sales numbers.
- Awards and award nominations you or your group has received (inc. ICONS).
- Your achievement of, or failure to achieve (just as important!), set goals.
- Your attendance at training sessions.
- Completed, or uncompleted admin tasks.
- Deadlines met/not met on time.
- Number of people you have supported.
